Recap: Use of speed (main consideration). 2 Second Rule. Speed limits.

Objective:

- What* Consider making progress in general driving.
- How* Discuss the safety aspects and how progress should be made for different situations followed by on road practice.

Main Points:

Make Progress - General You need to be able to drive at a realistic speed subject to:

Type of road - Volume and type of traffic

Weather conditions and visibility - Speed limits

When safe, keep to speed limit (dont drive too slowly - frusrates).

Keep up with traffic (use your judgement - limits, conditions etc).

Approach hazards at safe speed.

Don't hold up traffic by preparing too early for junctions.

Make Progress - Junctions Move off as soon as safe at junctions and roundabouts.

Develop and show confidence and good judgement

Don't be over cautious and stop/wait when safe to go.

Plan ahead and be prepared to take advantage of gaps

If you're going, GO!! - don't hang about, clear the junction ASAP.
